

Instructions

The indoor space is divided into five functional rooms: entry, break room, study, living room, and library. Materials and activities intended for each space are listed on the other side of the page.

Find ways of comfortably inhabiting the rooms, responding to the prompts as you choose. Enter, exit, or change spaces at any point. Take books or food or pages from room to room or back home with you.

Duration is an hour or more. It ends by consensus (people mostly leaving/talking/cleaning) or at a set time that is written on the map.

Possible Actions

Pull materials out of boxes or bags and put into use. Rearrange any space to better suit its function, or just because you want to.

Break room: Pass food around.

Library: Arrange and label books by genre/quality/color/size/language/print size/author.

Study: Draw lines between materials and activities you want to combine. Mark up a book or copy a passage from it. Ask a question in writing. Trade notes or pictures. Play tic-tac-toe with someone nearby. Write a paragraph about anything.

Living room: Listen to the place and people and objects. Think through a problem or project. Place a book or page from another room on a music stand.
